Writing creatively provides the opportunity to exercise and expand necessary skills for all types of composition in a fun and encouraging atmosphere. This creative writing class will focus briefly on genre analysis before moving on to our two main areas of concentration: poetry and fiction. Students will learn compositional skills that can be easily transferred to other types of writing as they create, revise, and polish their work. Expected assignments can include (but are not limited to) regular journaling, critical analyses of model texts, the creation of poems or short stories, the critique and revision of the same, and reflections on the writing process.

This class will meet from 2:30-4:00 p.m. on Mondays. Reliable internet access at home is highly recommended for the completion of this course.
