Notes - These should be neat and in chronological order. You should have your grammar notes and writing notes separate. If you want to put the grammar notes at the beginning of your grammar section that is fine. The same goes for your writing notes in your writing section. I'm fine with whatever you choose as long as it is logical, easy to find, and fairly legible.

Writing logs - 7 total since the beginning of the year.

Grammar/Mechanics section - each of these assignments should be corrected. If possible indicate where changes have been made using a different color or some other method. Since we corrected most of these in class, also include commentary on each assignment about the concept(s) needing reinforcement for that assignment.
